- TREE TYPE: Open tree
- VIGOR: Good
- AGRONOMY: Easy tree and good yields
- BLOOMING TIME: Similar to Gala
- HARVEST DATE: After Fuji
- BI-ANNUAL BEARING: Low susceptibility
- TOLERANCE TO PESTS & DISEASES: Genetic tolerance to Fire blight (FbF7).

The Fruit

Presentation: "Bicolored good-sized fruits, with pink to bright red uniform coloration"

- SIZE : 75-80 mm
- COLOR : Pink-red (50-80%) on yellow background
- SHAPE : Truncate conical
- RUSSET : Very low. Located in the stem bowl

Eating Quality: "Well-balanced taste, combining high sugar and acidity levels. Juiciness is good and makes this firm fruit easy to eat "

Storage Ability: "TONIK is a long keeping variety: in normal air storage with no 1-MCP, fruit can be kept over 6 months with good eating qualities: no internal disorder or storage diseases has been observed. "

"The fruit has an excellent storage potential and good eating qualities, the tree is productive and easy-to-grow. This makes TONIK appealing to growers, marketers and consumers."
