



LADINA

The Tree

- TREE TYPE: Open tree
- VIGOR: Medium
- PRODUCTIVITY: Good
- BLOOMING TIME: 1 days after Golden
- HARVEST DATE: first pick 2 weeks after the end of Gala (requires 2-3 picks)
- BIENNIAL BEARING: To be assessed.
- TOLERANCE TO PESTS & DISEASES : Scab resistant (Rvi6). QTL for fire blight and mildew tolerances also detected.

The Fruit

Presentation: "Attractive bicolored fruit, with white small lenticels and russet around the stem bowl."

- SIZE: About 75 mm
- OVER COLOUR: Red
- BACKGROUND COLOUR: Yellow
- SHAPE: Round
- RUSSET: Localized to the stem bowl

Eating Quality: "Sweet and moderately firm fruits which are recognizable by their surprising nice and strong peach aroma."

Storage Potential: "Ladina can be stored between 2 and 3 months in cold storage and have good shelf life abilities. Its storage can be extended until 5 months if fruits are kept under CA conditions."

Highlight

"Ladina belongs to the last generation of scab resistant varieties which have very good eating qualities. Its peach aromas make this variety unique."
